This gives rise to peculiar problems, the solution of which requires a specialised knowledge for those involved in their prevention and management, be they counsels, in-house counsels, legal officers, managers, government officials, or scholars interested in the phenomenon for scientific reasons.

The GLAM Master program aims at providing students with such knowledge from a holistic and entrepreneurial perspective, focusing not only on international arbitration but also delving into litigation before state and international courts.
